Secondly, to improve its communication with the residents by better connecting with them via an email mailing list, new website and paper newsletter where electronic communications are not available or appropriate.

- 3. To ensure the older generation have access to online services (online groceries, social services, social sites like streetlife.com)
- 4. Ensure the services are to a standard for family life (TV viewing eg. Netflix; online homework; online gaming)
